# How to earn the CFA Charter

## THE PATH TO BECOMING A CHARTERHOLDER

- Pass three levels of the CFA exam including Practical Skills Modules
- Submit reference letters
- Achieve qualified work experience
- Apply for CFA Institute Charterholder membership

## EXAM SUCCESS INCLUDES

### 300 Hours

300 hours of study per exam level plus completion of mandatory Practical Skills Module (PSM).

### Exam prep

All exam questions are based on CFA Program curriculum.

### Study tools

Online learning ecosystem, practice questions, mock exams, candidate discussion board, optional practice pack, CFA Institute learning mobile app, and approved prep provider list.

### 4+ Years

On average, it takes over four years to complete the full program (including mandatory work experience).

## ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

To enroll in the CFA Program and register for the Level I CFA exam, you must have an international travel passport and meet one of the following entrance requirements:

- **Bachelor's Degree**  
Completed a bachelor's program or equivalent program and received a university/college degree.
- **Current University Student**  
Be within 23 months from completing your undergraduate degree to begin your CFA Program journey.
- **Professional Work Experience**  
Have a combination of 4,000 hours of work experience and/or college/university education that was acquired over a minimum of three sequential years and achieved by the date of enrolling for the Level I exam. Dates of education and professional work experience cannot overlap.

## COMPLETE THREE LEVELS OF THE CFA EXAM

Focus areas vary by exam level, increasing in complexity and difficulty with a core of ethics and professional standards across all levels.
